I. We are in the people business.

- a. <u>Phoebe</u> (v. 1,2)
- b. Priscilla and Aquila (v. 3,4)
- c. <u>Epaenetus</u> (v. 5)
- d. <u>Mary</u> (v. 6)
- e. <u>Andronicus and Junia</u> (v. 7)
 - 1. <u>"my countrymen"</u> which most likely meant they were Jews like Paul.
 - 2. <u>"fellow prisoners"</u> which apparently meant that at some unrecorded time they were imprisoned with Paul.
 - 3. <u>"of note among the apostles"</u> which could mean that they were considered apostles by the early church or simply that they were highly regarded by the apostles.
 - 4. "were in Christ before me" which is pretty self-explanatory. They were Christians before Paul.
- f. the rest of Paul's contact list (v. 8-15; 21-24)

II. We are in the <u>protection business</u>.

Three duties we all can perform to help protect the church:

- a. <u>Observation</u> (v. 17)
- b. <u>Confrontation</u>
- c. <u>Separation</u> (v. 17b. 18)

God does not want us to be <u>naive</u> about doctrine but He does want us to be <u>innocent</u> about evil.
